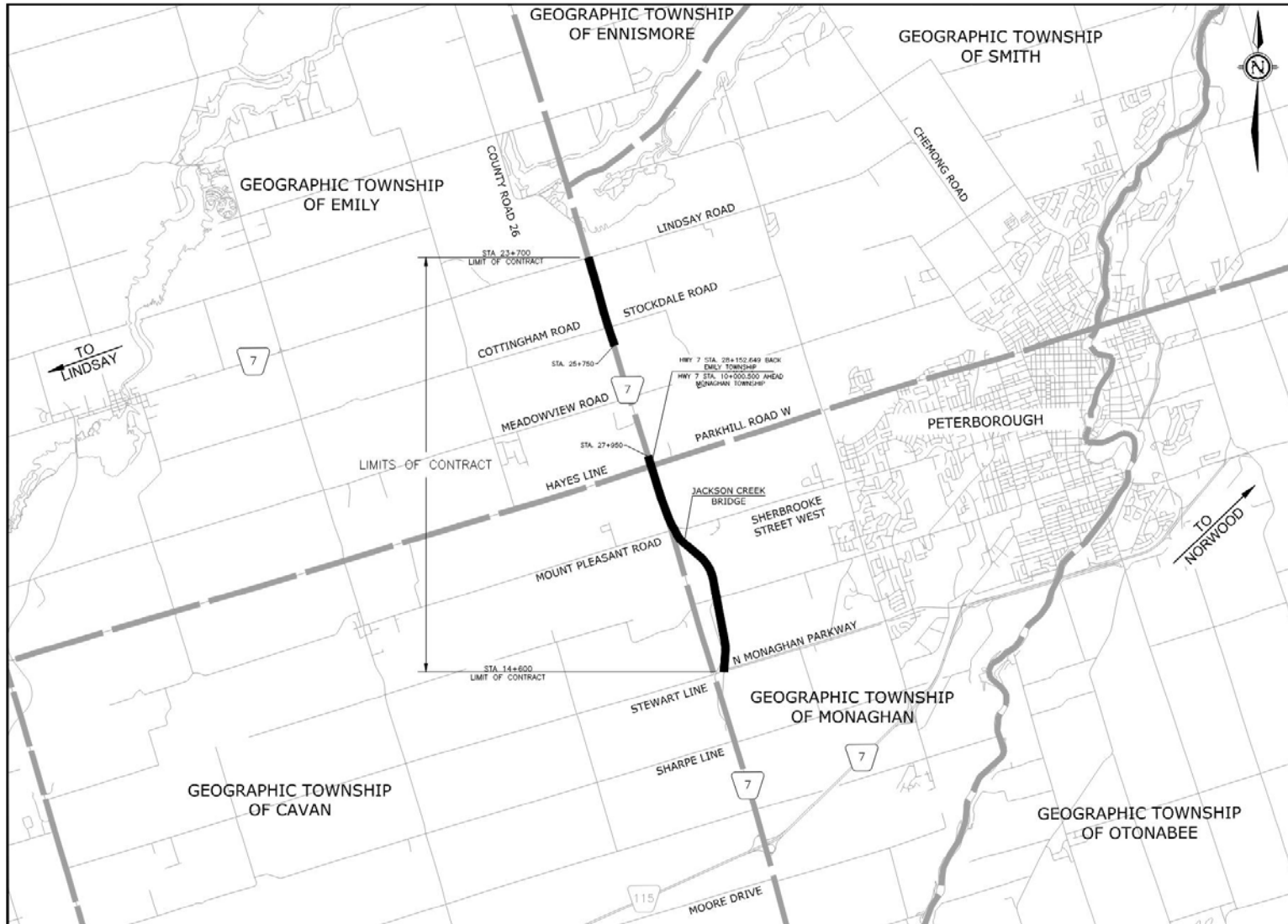

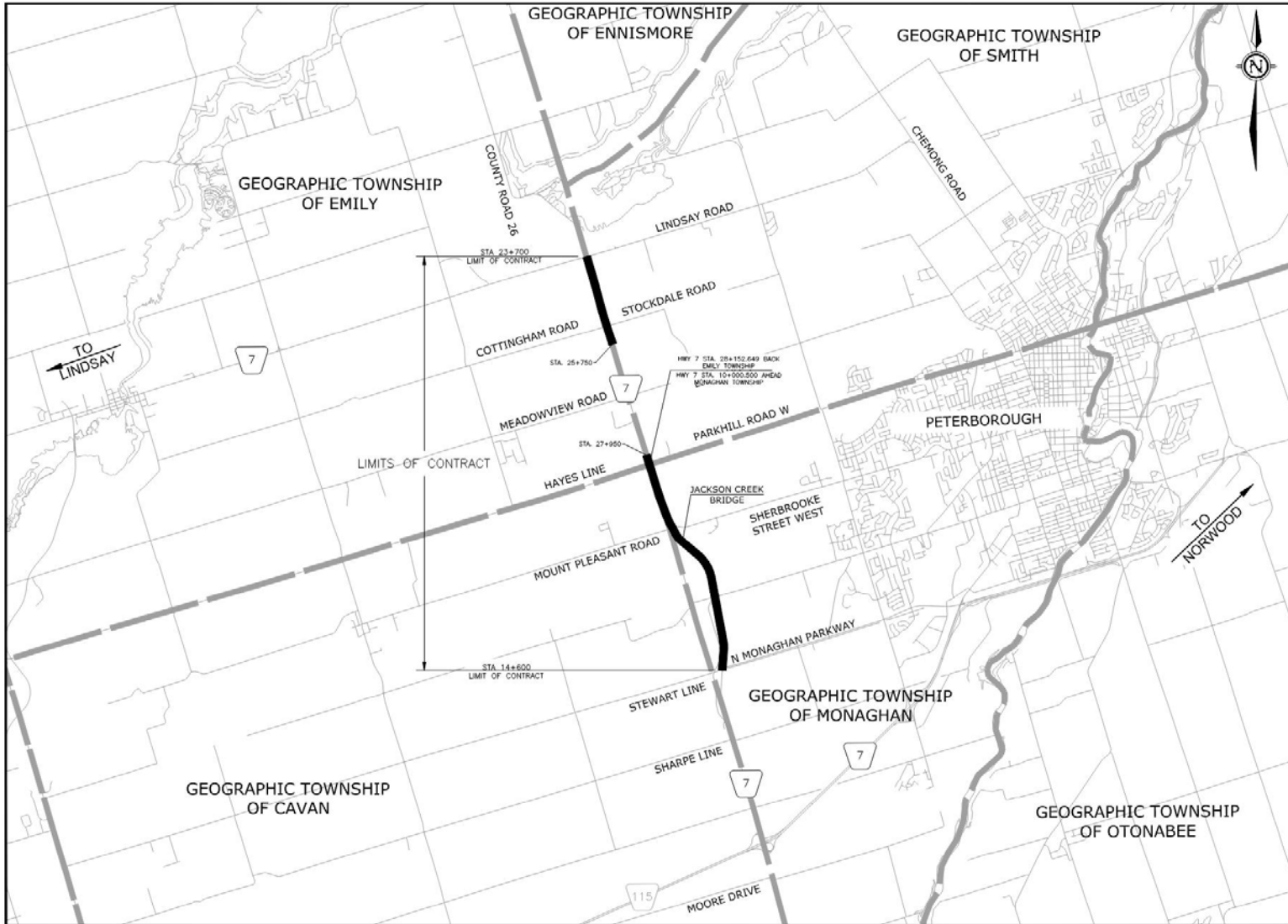

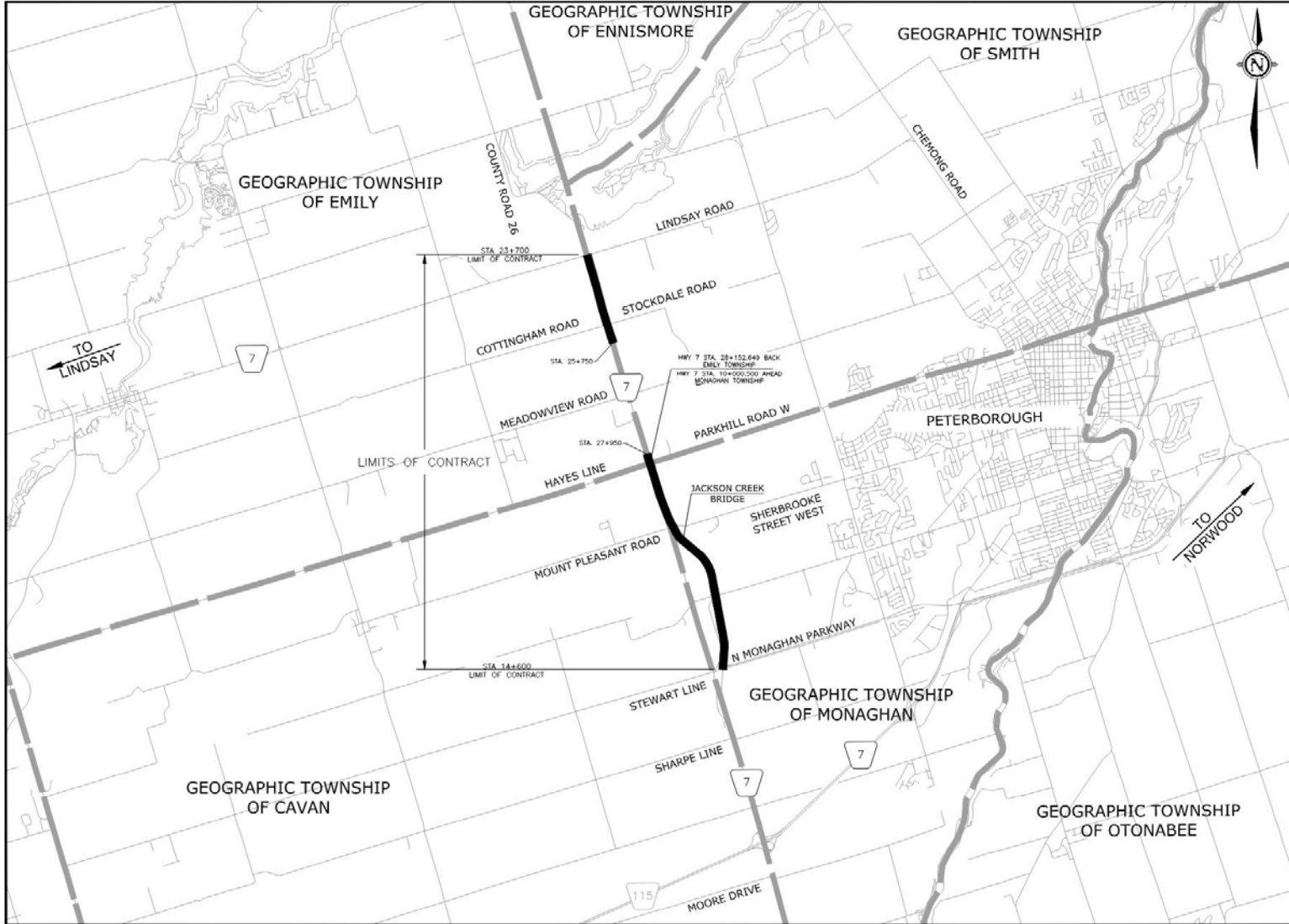

The Otonabee Region Conservation Authority (Otonabee Conservation) has received the above noted circulation notice and the following documentation in support of the application on December 23, 2024:

- Notice of Detailed Design Study – Pavement Resurfacing and Culvert Rehabilitation / Replacement dated November 22, 2024
- Figure 1 - Project Location Key Map

Otonabee Conservation has reviewed proposed infrastructure works and is pleased to provide the following comments:

The subject infrastructure maintenance and improvements are excluded from the definition of development under the Provincial Planning Statement (PPS). Therefore, Otonabee Conservation is of the opinion that the subject infrastructure works are consistent with Section 5 of the PPS referencing Natural Hazards.

Section 5(d) of Ontario Regulation 41/24 exempts proposed works under the *Conservation Authorities Act*. Therefore, permits from the Otonabee Conservation are not required for the infrastructure maintenance or improvements.

Otonabee Conservation has assessed the applicability of the [Trent Source Protection Plan \(SPP\)](#) prepared under the *Clean Water Act (CWA)*. The SPP came into effect on January 1, 2015, and contains policies to protect sources of municipal drinking water from existing and future land use activities that pose a significant [drinking water threat](#).

A portion of the study area lies in a Source Water Protection area where *Clean Water Act* policies apply. Where a *Planning Act*, *Building Code Act* or *Condominium Act* application is required, a Restricted Land Use Notice may be required. Based on the above referenced definition of infrastructure, it is not anticipated that a restricted land use notice will be required through the EA/Detail Design Study.

Enclosed in the attachments of this letter are regulated areas mapping (Figures 1-6) that outline locations of the mapped wetlands and streams.

Otonabee Conservation mapping also indicates that identified floodplain traverses the proposed infrastructure works area. Jackson Creek floodplain mapping (2022) is available through a data sharing agreement. Please contact our office if you require additional details.

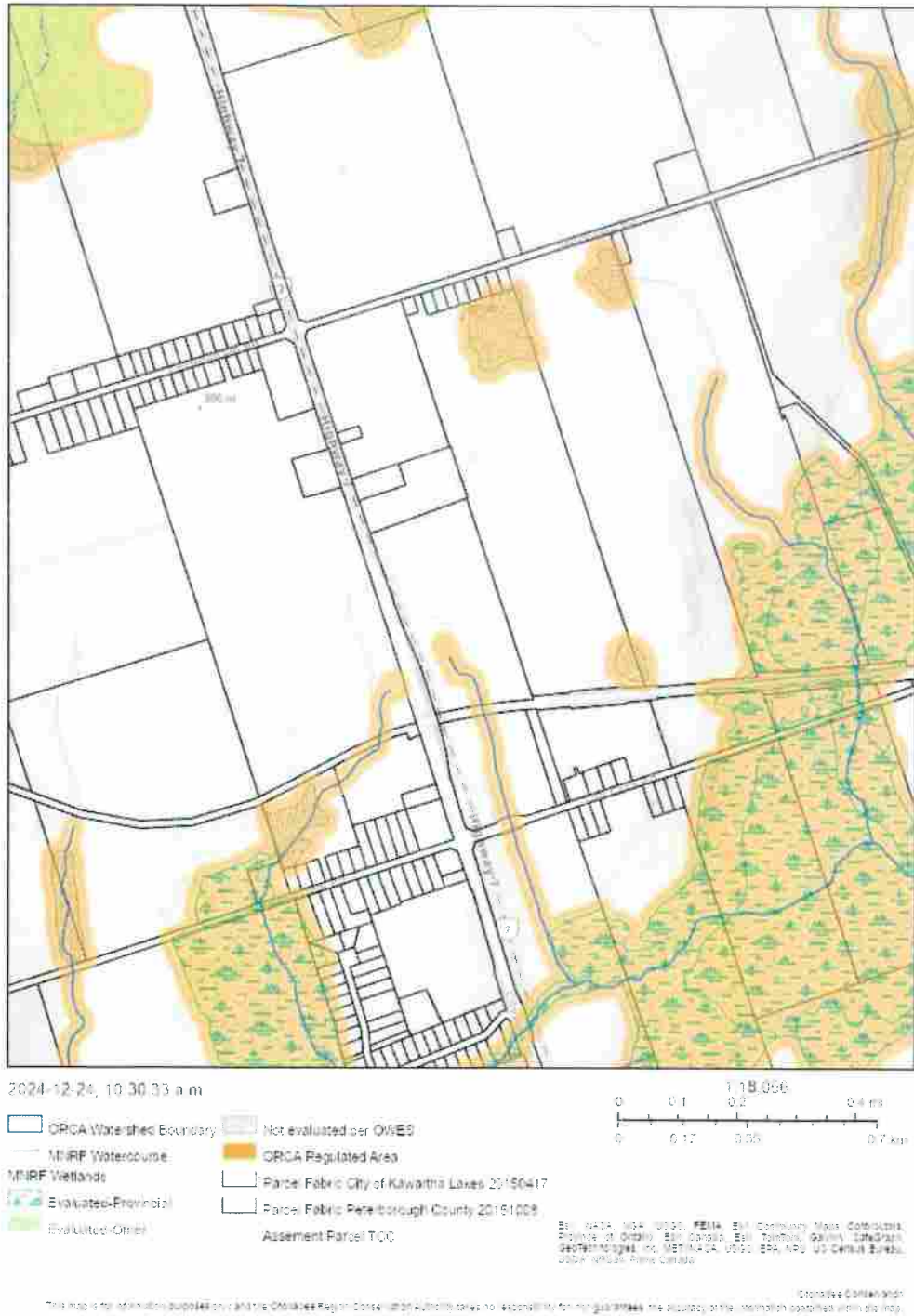


Figure 5: Regulatory Floodplain Screening Mapping

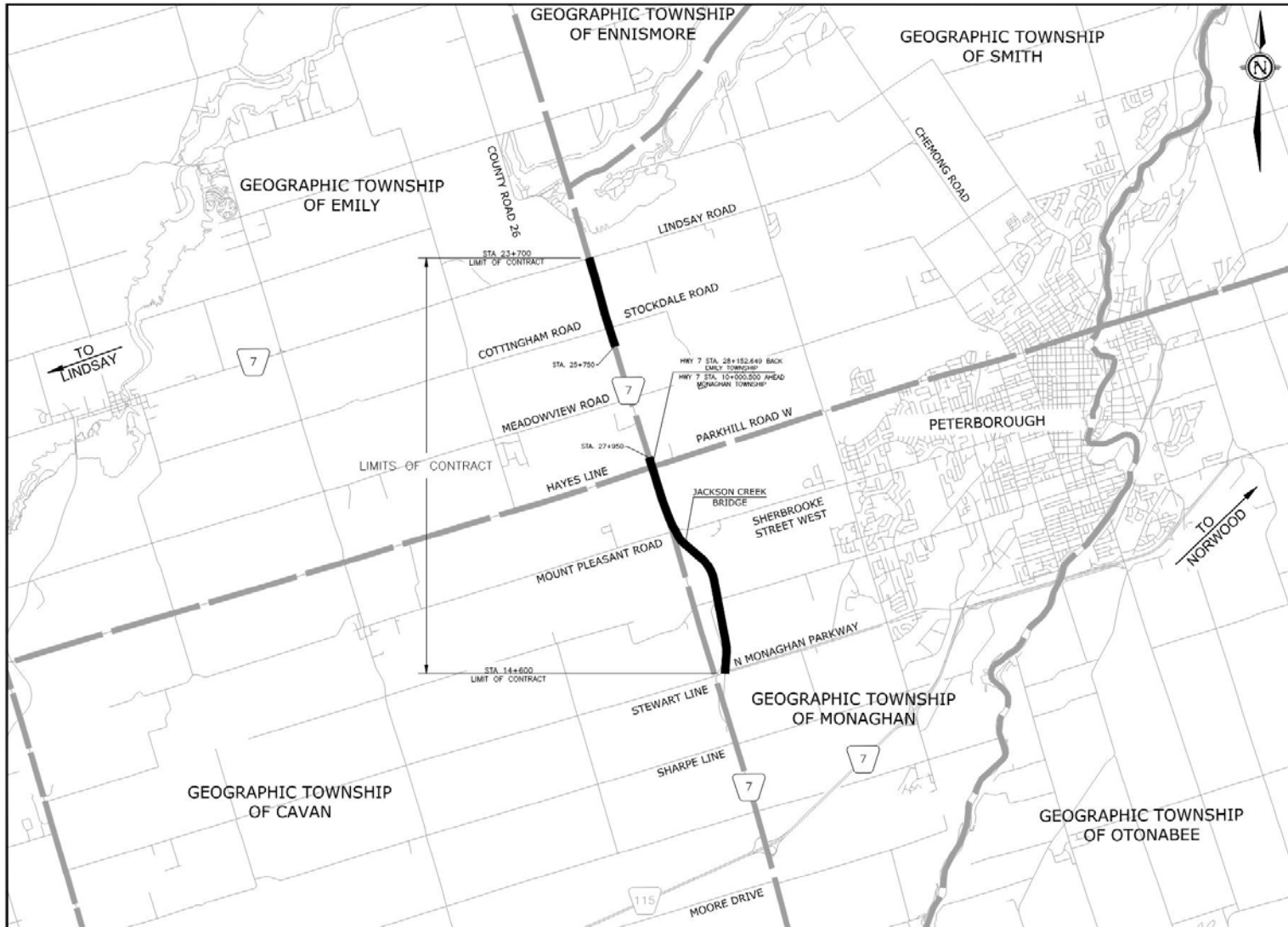

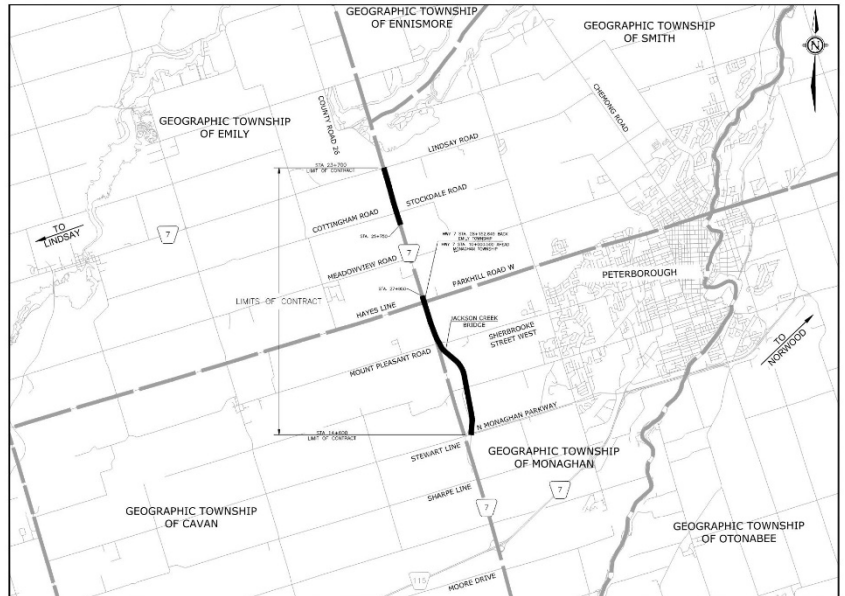

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) and their Consultant, Ainley Group, have completed the *Design and Construction Report (DCR)* for the Detail Design and Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for Highway 7 from County Road 26 (Fowler's Corners) to County Road 15 (North Monaghan Parkway), excluding a 2.2 kilometre (km) section from 1.1 km north of Lily Lake Road to 0.2 km north of Park Hill Road West. The DCR builds upon the recommended operational improvements identified as part of preliminary design activities for the Highway 7 corridor.



The recommended plan includes; highway resurfacing, signal upgrades, the replacement or rehabilitation of eleven (11) culverts / storm drains, the addition of left turn lanes at Stockdale Road, improvements to the southbound right turn lane at Maple Grove Road, and resurfacing of Jackson Creek Bridge.

Highway 7 and the intersecting roadways are expected to remain open during construction; however, short duration traffic delays may result from lane reductions associated with the proposed undertaking. Originally, night works were not anticipated; however, to fulfill design criteria, limited night work has been determined to be a requirement to facilitate the open-cut culvert replacement activities. Night work will be restricted to, up to four (4) weeknights with exact timing dependent on the successful contractor's construction schedule. Advanced signing will be placed in strategic locations on the highway and intersecting roads advising traffic of the temporary lane closures and night work. ## ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The Study followed the approved planning process for a Group B undertaking in accordance with the *Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000)*, with the opportunity for public input throughout. The DCR outlines the environmental assessment process followed, consultation, design details existing environmental conditions, impacts and mitigation measures, and contract specifications for construction.
